2. True or False? The fine reduction settlement program was instituted in 2005 and no longer exists today **TRUE**
3. True or False? Manhattan accounted for almost one-half of all parking tickets issued in New York City **TRUE**
4. True or False? Brooklyn accounted for the least amount of parking tickets issued in New York City **FALSE** (correct answer is Staten Island)
5. True or False? More parking tickets were issued on weekdays than weekends **TRUE**
6. True or False? Parking violations involving commercial vehicles happen mostly in Queens **FALSE** (correct answer is Manhattan)
7. True or False? Street cleaning violations are issued rarely in Staten Island **TRUE**
8. True or False? The most common violation issued in Staten Island is missing inspection sticker **TRUE**
9. True or False? 55% of all tickets issued in March 2010 were issued to vehicles that received more than two tickets that month **TRUE**
